FOREWORD

T-Mobile U.S. Inc. is America’s supercharged Un-carrier. We deliver transformational 4G LTE and nationwide 5G networks offering reliable connectivity for all. Our unrivaled combination of value and quality, dedication to the best possible service, and relentless drive for disruption benefits our customers and fosters competition and innovation in wireless and beyond. It’s what makes us the Un-carrier.

Our drive for excellence never stops. In 2020, despite extraordinary challenges, T-Mobile led the industry in customer growth and, through our merger with Sprint, acquired 2.5 GHz mid-band spectrum and other valuable assets. We’re positioned to lead the industry for the 5G era and beyond.

But we can’t lead alone – T-Mobile needs partners. Engaging in the political process is key to maintaining and enhancing our status as America’s Un-carrier. After all, public policy shapes our business every day. We engage the process through corporate political contributions, employee political action committee (PAC) contributions, lobbying, contributions to tax-exempt organizations, and our trade association memberships. Through these activities, we leverage our powerful brand and newfound scale to deliver more for shareholders, consumers, and employees.

T-Mobile participates in politics responsibly and transparently. This Report lists our 2020 PAC contributions, corporate political contributions, and independent expenditures. It also lists memberships in major trade associations and issue-advocacy organizations. The Report links to our federal lobbying reports and lists organizations that use at least some of our contributions to lobby. This Report covers 2020. Past support for a candidate or an organization does not entail current support.

A few bedrock commitments guide our political activities: the best interests of our customers and employees; strict compliance with local, state, and federal laws; bipartisan contributions; and strict adherence to our [Code of Business Conduct](#) and our Political Activities and Lobbying policy.

We strive to act as a force for good in public policy by:

- Expanding access to wireless spectrum so we can continue leading the industry in 5G and meet the ever-growing demand for mobile data.
- Maintaining fiscal and tax policies that encourage us to invest in people and our networks, for the benefit of our employees and consumers everywhere.
- Supporting transparent privacy practices and giving users control over how their personal data is used and shared.
- Advocating for diversity, equity, and inclusion to align with our strong company values in this area.
- Expanding affordable access to broadband services to unserved and underserved communities.

Together with shareholders, customers, employees, and public officials at all levels of government, T-Mobile is using its voice as the supercharged Un-carrier to bring reliable connectivity to all.

We advocate for our shareholders, employees, and customers in the following ways:**Political Action Committee (PAC)**

T-PAC is T-Mobile's federal political action committee (T-PAC) – a separate, segregated fund established by T-Mobile, but funded entirely by voluntary contributions from eligible employees. T-PAC financially supports the federal election campaigns of candidates who share T-Mobile's views on important issues directly related to our business goals, who want to learn more about the public policy issues that affect our business, represent geographical areas where we have a large employee concentration, or meet other criteria. T-PAC is very proud to be bipartisan, spending its resources between both political parties at an even rate. This includes supporting national party committees on both sides of the aisle in addition to other political action committees. T-PAC does not make political contributions based upon party affiliation, positions taken on non-company related issues, or in anticipation of, in recognition of, or in return for, an official act.

As the Un-carrier, we're in the business of amplifying voices. T-PAC helps us do it. T-PAC gives individual donors, who might not otherwise be involved in the political process, an opportunity to be heard by those policymakers who set the nation's public policy agenda on topics directly related to T-Mobile.

We believe we accomplish this by working on both sides of the aisle with policymakers who may share different perspectives on the same issues.

Since the official close of our merger with Sprint on April 1, 2020, T-PAC and Sprint PAC operated as separate, but affiliated political action committees. Sprint made no PAC contributions after the merger, and its contributions for the first quarter of 2020 are included in this report. Further, Sprint PAC dissolved at the end of 2020. Operations moving forward continue solely under the T-PAC banner.

State Contributions

On an average day, Washington, D.C. seems like the center of the political universe – but there’s more out there. Fifty states and the District of Columbia means 51 potential sets of laws and rules to navigate. Plus, when it comes to regulations, the federal government may set floors, but states can set their own ceilings. In short, states are hubs of activity, too. T-Mobile goes to bat for our shareholders, employees, and customers in state capitals nationwide. Although federal law bars political contributions to federal candidates and their parties directly from corporate treasuries, some states allow corporate funds to be spent on political races. We may give directly to state office candidates when doing so is permitted under state law. No matter the state, we always make sure our donations are properly reported, within applicable limits, and consistent with all other laws. This report reflects all state giving in 2020.

Trade Associations

There’s strength in numbers. That’s why T-Mobile participates in trade associations. Trade associations are groups of companies that band together to make their industry’s voice heard in government. Trade associations explain wireless networks, advocate for wireless services, and, at times, contribute through their PACs to candidates and officials, who want the industry to succeed. Sometimes policy issues implicate T-Mobile alone, but other times the entire industry segment needs to speak with one voice. Trade organizations make that job easier by coordinating the work.

This Report identifies T-Mobile’s significant donations to trade associations. Just like with PACs and state giving, we value accountability in our trade association memberships. We also value our independence. Donating to trade associations does not mean T-Mobile goes against its competitive spirit. Working with trade associations allows us to collaborate with like-minded companies on ways to improve business conditions for the wireless sector as a whole.

Public Policy

Good public policy rests on relationships and storytelling. Lobbying lets us do both. By building relationships with policymakers, T-Mobile’s advocates help ensure the nation’s laws make it easier, not harder, for T-Mobile to bring forth the innovation that has made us the largest, fastest, and most reliable 5G wireless operator in the nation. We rely on employees and consultants to carry our message. By explaining how wireless connectivity can transform lives, T-Mobile helps officeholders understand the real story of our company, customers, and employees.
