FOREWORD

T-Mobile U.S. Inc. is America's supercharged Un-carrier. We deliver transformational nationwide 5G networks offering reliable connectivity for all. Our unrivaled combination of value and quality, dedication to the best possible service, and relentless drive for disruption benefits our customers and fosters competition and innovation in wireless and beyond. It's what makes us the Un-carrier.

Our drive for excellence never stops. At the beginning of 2021, we set bold goals for T-Mobile's customer growth, profitability, network deployment, and merger integration. By year end, we had exceeded all expectations with record-setting customer growth and an unparalleled network build that delivered Ultra Capacity 5G to an astonishing 210 million people.

We want to bring out the best in others too. Engaging in the political process helps us ensure the industry grows more competitive, resilient, and responsive alongside us. Public policy shapes our business every day. We engage that process through corporate political contributions, employee political action committee (PAC) contributions, lobbying, contributions to tax-exempt organizations, and our trade association memberships. Through these activities, we use our brand and scale to deliver more for shareholders, consumers, and employees.

T-Mobile participates in politics responsibly and transparently. This Report lists our 2021 PAC contributions, corporate political contributions, and independent expenditures. It also lists significant memberships in major trade associations and issue-advocacy organizations. Support for a candidate or an organization in this report does not entail support in years other than 2021.

A few bedrock commitments guide our political activities: the best interests of our customers and employees; strict compliance with local, state, and federal laws; bipartisan contributions; and strict adherence to our [Code of Business Conduct](#) and our Political Activities and Lobbying policy.

We strive to act as a force for good in public policy by:

- Expanding access to wireless spectrum so we can continue leading the industry in 5G.
- Maintaining fiscal and tax policies that encourage us to invest in people and infrastructure.
- Promoting spectrum policies that allow for new services and advance innovation.
- Advocating for diversity, equity, and inclusion in our business and throughout the country.
- Expanding affordable access to broadband services to unserved and underserved communities.

We advocate for our shareholders, employees, and customers in the following ways:**Political Action Committee (PAC) - Federal Political Giving**

T-PAC is T-Mobile's political action committee (T-PAC), a separate, segregated fund established by T-Mobile, but funded entirely by voluntary contributions from eligible employees. Because federal election law prohibits corporations from using corporate dollars to make political contributions to candidates running to federal office, T-PAC allows the company to financially contribute to the election campaigns of federal candidates. These are candidates who share T-Mobile's views on important issues directly related to our business goals, who want to learn more about the public policy issues that affect our business, represent geographical areas where we have a large employee concentration, or meet other criteria. T-PAC is staunchly bipartisan, spending its resources between both political parties uniformly. This includes supporting both Democratic and Republican national party committees in addition to other political action committees. T-PAC does not make political contributions based upon party affiliation, positions taken on non-company related issues, or in anticipation of, in recognition of, or in return for, an official act.

As the Un-carrier, we're in the business of amplifying voices which T-PAC helps us do. T-PAC gives individual donors, who might not otherwise be involved in the political process, an opportunity to connect with policymakers who set the nation's agenda on topics relevant to T-Mobile's business and the wireless industry.

Deepening political fissures among the American public have made T-PAC's job of stimulating dialogue more challenging – and more important – than ever. In 2021, we saw continued fallout from measures to combat the global Covid-19 pandemic; challenges to the peaceful transfer of power; and continued discussion surrounding racial, social, and gender equity. T-PAC continues to give its members a collective say in the democratic process and is working to build a more connected, equitable, inclusive, and sustainable future for everyone.

State Political Giving

Even though Washington, D.C. seems like the center of the political universe, there are 51 (fifty states and the D.C.) potential sets of laws and rules to navigate. When it comes to regulations, the federal government may set floors, but states can raise the floor, or set ceilings. In short, states are hubs of activity, too. T-Mobile works on behalf of our shareholders, employees, and customers in state capitals nationwide.

Although federal law bars political contributions to federal candidates and their parties directly from corporate treasuries, some states allow corporate funds to be spent on political races. We may give directly to state office candidates when doing so is permitted under state law. No matter the state, we always make sure our donations are properly reported, within applicable limits, and consistent with all other laws. This report reflects all state giving in 2021.

Trade Associations/Coalitions

There's strength in numbers which is why T-Mobile participates in trade associations and coalitions. Trade associations are groups of companies that band together to make their industry's voice heard in government. Trade associations explain wireless networks, advocate for wireless services, and, at times, contribute through their PACs to candidates and officials, who want the industry to succeed. Sometimes policy issues affect T-Mobile alone, but oftentimes new rules can challenge the industry as a whole. Trade organizations make that job easier by coordinating the work. Coalitions are similar to trade associations, in that they are a group of stakeholders that work together around a common goal, issue set and/or policy change.

This Report identifies T-Mobile's significant donations to trade associations and coalitions. Just like with PACs and state giving, we value accountability in our memberships. We also value our independence. Donating to trade associations or coalitions does not make our competitive instincts any less fierce. Working with these groups allows us to collaborate with like-minded companies on ways to improve business conditions for the wireless sector as a whole.

Public Policy

Good public policy rests on relationships and storytelling. Lobbying lets us do both. By building relationships with policymakers, T-Mobile's advocates help ensure the nation's laws make it easier for T-Mobile to continue to innovate in the ways that have made us the largest, fastest, and most reliable 5G wireless operator in the nation. We rely on employees and consultants to carry our message. By explaining how wireless connectivity can transform lives, T-Mobile helps officeholders understand the real story of our company, our customers, and our employees.
